PLANT DESCRIPTIONS**

SPECIES	DESCRIPTION
BALSAM FIR	Excellent Christmas tree. Fragrant, soft, flat 1¼" needles. Narrow pyramidal growth to 75'.
COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE	A premier Christmas tree in 9 years. Sharp blue-green needles. Excellent screen. Matures to 100'. Tolerates heavy soils.
WHITE FLOWERING DOGWOOD	Beautiful white flowers in the spring. Red berries in the fall are great for wildlife. Great as specimen or in groupings. Grows to 40'.
NORWAY SPRUCE	Dense, dark green, 1-inch needles. Valued as an ornamental and excellent for windbreaks. Branches droop gracefully. Fast growth to 80'. Good in heavy soils.
AUSTRIAN PINE	Fast growing, excellent screen or windbreak. Grows to 60' high. Does equally well in acidic and limestone soils. Somewhat salt resistant.
PAPER BIRCH	Bark turns brilliant white with age and peels in thin sheets. Plant one or more per hole. Narrowly rounded shape. Grows to 60'.
PIN OAK	Distinctive branching habit with upper branches upright, middle ones horizontal and lower limbs slanting towards the earth. Full sun, tolerates wet soils. Fast growth to 70'.
RUGOSA ROSE	Excellent hedge, pink or white flowers, 6', salt tolerant. Full sun in well drained soils. Plant one foot apart for hedge.
FORSYTHIA (Lynwood Gold)	Full sun to partial sun, famous for yellow flowers appearing in early spring before foliage emerges. Grows well in most soils, good screen, to 7'.
HIGH BUSH BLUEBERRIES	Provides food for 36 species of birds and other animals. Needs moist, acid soils. Limited quantities, excellent stock!! Grows to 6'. 2 varieties included for good pollination.
RED RASPBERRY	A summer-bearing fruit, old favorite bramble. Best planted in clean tilled plots, remove any wild varieties prior to planting. Excellent to eat! Plant 18 inches apart.
LILAC (Old Fashioned)	Traditional favorite. Large, purple flowers, hardy plant. Great for screen, hedge or as a specimen. Grows 10-12'.
SPIREA (Shirobana)	Three colors of blooms from white to pink to dark pink from May-August. Fast growth to 4', full sun to partial shade.
ROSE OF SHARON	Single or double flowers in a range of colors. Flowers profusely during summer when most other shrubs have finished blooming. Full sun, 8-10' high. Good screen or specimen. Hardy to -20° F.
PRIVET (Amur River)	Makes an excellent green privacy fence. Fast, upright growth to 10', but can be trimmed to any size. Clusters of white flowers in late spring. Sun or shade. Plant 2-4 ft. apart.
RED OSIER DOGWOOD	Fast growing ornamental shrub which provides year round interest. Flat white clusters of blossoms in the spring, berries from summer to fall, and bright red branches in the winter. Effective for erosion control and an excellent wildlife plant. Grows 8' in height and spread. Will grow in shady, wet areas.
GROUND COVER	
PACHYSANDRA	Excellent low evergreen ground cover, shade tolerant, fragrant white flowers. Plant 6" apart.
PERIWINKLE	Attractive, dark green leaves, bluish-purple flowers, sun or shade, evergreen. These are plants, not rooted cuttings. Plant on 6" centers, covers 20 sq. ft. Grows to 6" tall. Outstanding ground cover. Excellent value!
CROWN VETCH SEED MIX	For use on special areas such as steep banks and difficult to mow areas. Covers up to 1,200 sq. ft. Profuse pink and white flowers. Does not need mowing.
WILDFLOWER SEED MIX	Has 17 varieties to suit a variety of conditions and provide a full spectrum of color and bloom times. Covers 1,300 sq. ft. Prep like lawn bed for best results.
CONSERVATION SEED MIX	Mix of trefoil, red fescue, tall fescue, and annual rye grass. Great for erosion control and as cover for large, bare areas. Low maintenance, mow 1 to 2 times per year. Covers 8,000 sq. ft.
MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS	
COMPOST	30 lbs of leaf compost to enrich the soil for your trees and shrubs.
WOOD CHIPS	30 lb. of wood chips for weed control and moisture retention around trees and shrubs.
BLUE BIRD HOUSE	Design recommended by "Blue Bird Society". Best to place in pairs 20 ft. apart, every 300 Feet.
FERTILIZER TABLETS	10 grams each of 20-10-5 non-burning fertilizer. Use 1-2 per tree. Lasts 2 years. Packages of 10 tablets.
SULFUR	Use to reduce soil pH for blueberries. Mix with soil when planting. 1 lb. package does 5 plants.
