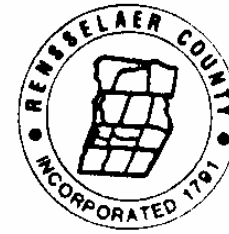


WRAP has changed! Here are a list of repairs that are NO longer covered because they are not energy related.

These include:

- Ramps
- Shower grab bars
- Replacing steps
- Replacing railings
- Replacing refrigerators
- Carbon dioxide detectors
- Smoke alarms
- Routine issues related to septic tanks
- Extermination services
- Replace rotting deck
- Plumbing repairs
- Structural integrity issues
- Gutter replacement
- Skirting on trailers
- Chimney repairs
- Electrical repairs
- Asbestos removal
- Repair/replace vinyl siding

## WRAP

Would you like to save more money on your home heating bill through lowering your energy consumption, while having more money to spend on necessities such as food, clothing, or medical care?

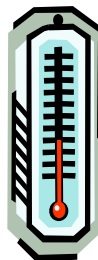
## What is WRAP and How can it help you...

Older homes are susceptible to inadequate insulation, drafts, and malfunctioning heating systems. Frequently, these repairs are too costly for seniors to have repaired.

WRAP, also known as the weatherization, referral, and packaging program, is designed to help low- income seniors with minor home repairs related to inadequate heating and cooling.

The program is designed to help seniors reduce their energy consumption through repairs that better insulate windows, pipes, doors, and other areas of the home.

WRAP helps seniors see savings in their utility or fuel bill, while also helping them remain in their home.



## How to apply...

In order to receive WRAP benefits you must be HEAP eligible. HEAP eligibility is based on income, household size, and you must be at least 60 years of age. If you are unsure about your eligibility contact the HEAP office at (518) 270-3935.
