RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR LIQUID POLYMER - SEWER DISTRICT NO. 1

WHEREAS, The 2017 Rensselaer County Adopted Budget for Sewer District No. 1 Budget provides an appropriation for the purposes of the annexed competitively bid liquid polymer contract; and

WHEREAS, The District, in conjunction with the county purchasing department developed a bid specification based on plant history; and

WHEREAS, The lowest responsible bid was received on January 26, 2017 from Polydyne, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, The start and end dates of such contract, the source of funding of the same, the total amount to be expended over the life of the same, which shall not exceed budgeted appropriations, and the name and address of the contracting parties are as follows:
