**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR AUTOMOTIVE COLLISION REPAIRS  
FOR AUTO MAINTENANCE, HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT AND SEWER DISTRICT -  
BUREAU OF CENTRAL SERVICES**

**WHEREAS,** This resolution is filed with the Rensselaer County Legislature by the Rensselaer County Executive; and

**WHEREAS,** The Rensselaer County Budget provides appropriations for Automotive Collision Repairs of County Fleet Chevrolet and Chrysler/Dodge vehicles; and following evaluation of bids submitted in response to RFB-18-15, awards are being recommended to the below-listed Vendors based upon the lowest Unit Prices/Discounts for parts and labor per category meeting specifications:

**WHEREAS,** According to the bid specifications Rensselaer County intends to send vehicles to the lowest cost successful bidder until the primary shop reaches full capacity. Once the primary shop has reached full capacity, the next lowest cost successful bidder's shop will be utilized; and

**WHEREAS,** The contract will be effective June 1, 2018 through May 31, 2019 with the option to renew for two (2) one (1) year terms. In the second and third year of the contract agreement, at Rensselaer County's option, the Contractor may receive a Unit Daily Cost increase not to exceed the prevailing Consumer Price Index (CPI); now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** That all County departments may purchase from the above-referenced bid, provided expenditures do not exceed budgetary appropriations; and, be it further

**RESOLVED,** That the Director of the Bureau of Central Services shall be and hereby is authorized and empowered to execute purchases from said vendor for products listed within the above-referenced bid.
