



USE OF FORCE STATISTICS- 2022

In 2022, the Rensselaer County Sheriff's Office Highway Patrol responded to 18,911 calls for service, and 463 arrests were made as a result of complaints or investigations. Any instance of the Highway Patrol use of force on the part of officers is thoroughly documented and has been reviewed, and all incidents for 2022 were found to be appropriate, given the circumstances at that time.

The term "Brandish" (to point at a person or persons) is defined in the New York State Executive Law and New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services Use of Force Reporting requirements.

HIGHWAY PATROL USE OF FORCE 2022

- 0-instances of Oleoresin capsaicin (pepper spray) being brandished
