

How Do I Apply for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) *(formerly known as Food Stamps)?*

You can now apply for SNAP online, by mail, fax, or in person at your local Social Services District Office or New York City HRA Center.

- **Apply Online** - You may apply for SNAP using the internet if you live in New York State by going to myBenefits.ny.gov.
- **Apply by mail, fax or in person** - You may apply by filing an application by mail, fax, or in person at your local Social Services District Office or New York City HRA Center. You may pick up an application, request an application to be mailed to you, or print an application by going to <http://otda.ny.gov/programs/apply/#fs>. The current SNAP application form is available to print in English, Spanish, Arabic, Chinese, Haitian-Creole, Italian, Korean and Russian. To find the location of your nearest local Social Services District Office or New York City HRA Center go to <http://otda.ny.gov/programs/apply/#fs>.
- If you are applying for other assistance programs (Temporary Assistance, Medicaid) at the same time that you are applying for SNAP benefits, use the common application form, LDSS-2921. You may pick up an application, request an application to be mailed to you, or print an application by going to <http://otda.ny.gov/programs/applications/2921.pdf>. The current common application form is available to print in English, Spanish, Arabic, Chinese, Haitian-Creole, Italian, Korean and Russian.

In many locations throughout New York State, community organizations and nutrition outreach providers can help you get and complete an application for SNAP.
